THURSDAYS - CHANGED LIVES
Dates: 18th, 25th June; 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th July; 6th August

- For lasting responses where children/young people's lives are radically changed.
- Effective discipleship of new Christians.
- That children/young people would have enthusiasm and energy to make a difference, and be eager to have fellowship, and support from other Christians.

FRIDAYS - OUR ORGANISATION
